ITINERARY

DAY 1 : CANCÚN

Meet and greet upon arrival at Cancun International Airport. Your guide will be waiting to take you to your hotel. Free evening.

DAY 2 : CANCÚN – VALLADOLID – IZAMAL – MÉRIDA

Breakfast at the hotel.

Departure for Valladolid (3-hour drive). We'll start the day with a guided tour of this colorful city. Its colonial architecture reflects its Spanish heritage. The splendor of its colonial riches has earned the city the nickname "Sultana of the East." This city is the perfect place to savor some typical dishes of Yucatán's regional cuisine. We'll continue on to Izamal, located between Valladolid and Mérida. This all-yellow village, with its colonial-style streets, offers a magnificent setting for strolling and taking photos. You'll be surprised by its very present Mayan and Spanish heritage.

DAY 3 : MÉRIDA – UXMAL

Breakfast at the hotel.

Visit the archaeological site of Uxmal, the most important Mayan site in the Puuc region. In Uxmal, you can admire Mayan sculptures and an impressive 39-meter-high pyramid.

You'll end the day with a panoramic tour of the city of Mérida, whose historic center is the second largest in Mexico after Mexico City's. Thanks to its unique geographical location, strong Spanish influence, and isolation from the rest of Mexico, Mérida has developed a distinct cultural and political identity. Its unique culture and traditions are clearly reflected in traditional clothing, language, cuisine, and the way festivals and holidays are celebrated. Mérida's cuisine also differs from traditional Mexican cuisine, as it has been influenced by the local indigenous culture as well as Caribbean, Mexican, European, and Middle Eastern flavors.

DAY 4 : MÉRIDA – CHICHEN ITZÁ – CANCÚN

Breakfast at the hotel.

Guided tour of Chichen Itzá, one of the New Seven Wonders of the World. This archaeological site is undoubtedly the most famous in the Mayan world. The Mayans had a deep understanding of astrology, which is why they built Chichen Itzá's most famous pyramid in alignment with the sun. Thus, on the day of the spring equinox, thanks to a play of shadows, one can admire the god Kukulcan (the feathered serpent) descending the pyramid's staircase.

Finally, return to Cancún, where the bus will drop you off at the airport for your return flights, or at the hotel for those extending their stay.
